

Tourism

Level 2

Course Requirements:

Students who are: reliable (especially having a good attendance), hard-working, able to work independently and have an interest in working in the tourism and travel industry, should have no trouble in achieving success in this subject.

Aims:

As well as providing the knowledge and skills necessary to pursue further study in Tourism (for example, onto NCEA Level 3), this course also aims to provide students with an understanding of the huge range of job opportunities available in the tourism and travel industry.

Course Content:

The course covers an Introduction to tourism: its characteristics, importance, products and key New Zealand and world destinations. As well, it covers the personal requirements and qualities that are necessary to be successful in this field.

Where can this subject take you?

This subject leads onto Level Three Tourism, and all credits gained qualify for the New Zealand Certificate of Tourism (Level Two). Pathways from school lead to tertiary study at the technical institutes and to the various tourism and travel colleges found in Auckland. As well, it provides a good stepping stone towards acquiring a job in the travel and tourism industry.

Further Assessment Opportunity and Resubmission (Refer to student Handbook for more information)

A further assessment opportunity occurs after you have submitted work / sat a test for an assessment; you do a new assessment after further learning has taken place. For this course there will be one further assessment opportunity for each standard. A resubmission can be offered to you by the teacher if they believe you can correct errors or omissions in your work in a short period of time; it does not involve a new assessment. A resubmission must take place before the teacher gives any feedback on the work done. There can be only one resubmission.

Appeals (Please refer to student Handbook for more information)

If you are unhappy with any of your results you should discuss this with your teacher. If you are still unhappy then an Appeals form should be completed; this is available from the HoF; forms need to be completed and returned to your HoF within 5 school days of receiving your grade. If you are still not happy you can then see the Principal's Nominee. At NO time, during this process, should you contact NZQA.
