- They will help you with everything

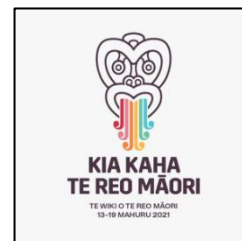
### Te Wiki o te Reo Māori – Te Papa's On-line Quiz

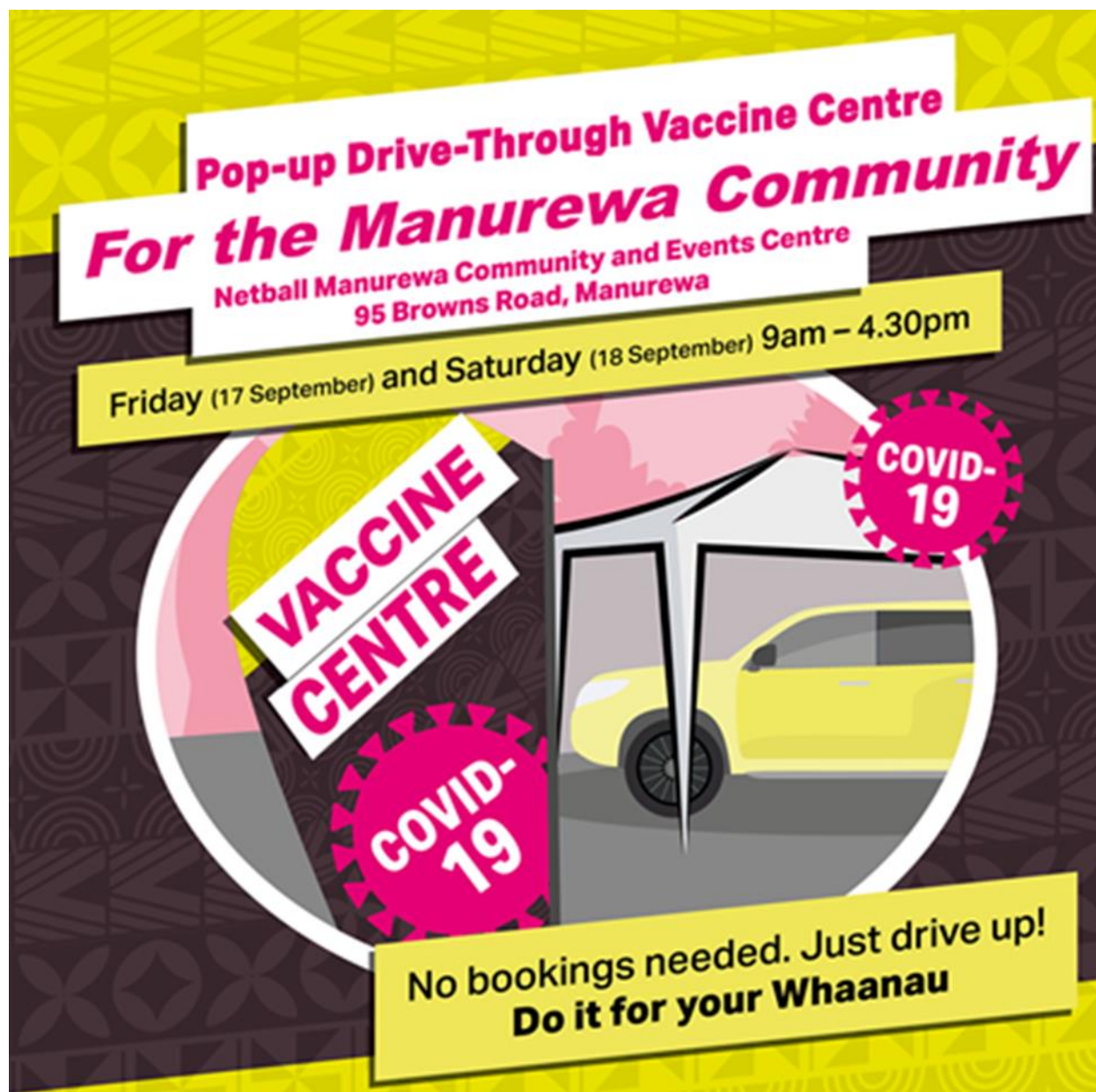
### JCHS Students and Staff Assisting Manurewa Marae & the DHB
