For schools, Level 3 is the same as Level 4 - except it is only the children of essential workers that can be at school during the day but under strict conditions. These conditions include having to wear a face mask whilst in the school.

If all goes well, it **looks like the first day back at school** may be Monday 18<sup>th</sup> October - but don't write that on your calendar yet!


