We are well aware that Mountfort Park is a popular place in the evenings as people and whānau safely exercise and walk. Including young people doing the same.

If you were at the Sports Centre three evenings ago (on Monday 20th September) between 5pm to 8pm there is a risk that you have been exposed to Covid-19.

If you were there at that time the health advice is to self isolate for 14 days, and if you start feeling symptoms to get a Covid Test and stay isolated until you get a negative result and 24 hours after symptoms have gone. The website www.health.govt.nz has more information.

Manurewa Marae has a Covid Testing Centre on Weymouth Road, opposite the BP.

Please do not be whakamā or embarrassed about this. No one deliberately catches or spreads Covid-19. If you or a member of your whānau were at the Sports Centre please follow health advice.



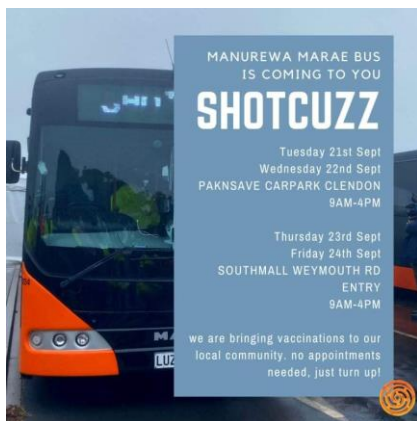
