Government Decisions Today

We will know more on Wednesday, when the Minister for Education (and Covid Response) is due to make a further announcement.

I do not believe the Minister will announce a date for re-opening schools. I think it is more likely he will announce a set of conditions that need to be in place so that schools can re-open. Things such as vaccination rates and the number of cases in Tāmaki Makaurau are likely to be part of these conditions.

So, please plan for 2 or 3 more weeks before our school site can reopen. It may be that school sites don't fully re-open in early November, but might start opening only to some year levels (e.g. NCEA students).

We should know more about this on Wednesday, and more again on Friday.

Learning at Home

I am busy re-recording a couple of videos about this and these will be online tomorrow morning.

The most important thing we can do right now is to connect with our students and for our students to connect with us.
