School is Re-opening for Year 11, 12 and 13 Students

Chris Hipkins, Minister for Education (and Covid Response Minister) has announced that **we can re-open for NCEA students on Tuesday next week, 26th October.**

This is great news!

We have already planned ahead in detail for when we re-open and held back on sharing this too soon because we didn't know when or how re-opening would happen, especially as during this lockdown things kept changing.

We want to reassure whānau that we are fully prepared for the re-opening and have steps in place to make our school safe with ventilation, mask-use, sanitiser, and routines.

We have analysed every single Year 11, 12 and 13 student's achievement so far, and put together an individual plan for each student to complete their NCEA qualification. This includes a weekly progress report for them and their whānau.
