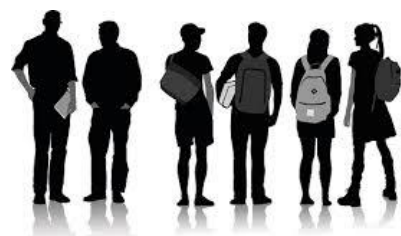
### Year 9 and 10 Students
