

Kia ora koutou,

Next week we are going to share with you and celebrate two significant reports on our school. These reports are by external independent agencies and they thoroughly check the most important parts of our school, what we do, and how successful we are.

In tonight's and tomorrow's newsletters I will explain a little about each organisation and what they do.



NZ Qualifications Authority

NZQA administers qualifications throughout NZ and across secondary schools, tertiary institutions and workplaces.

For schools, NZQA makes sure that a school is legally and properly administering NCEA. They check that the assessments and decisions a school makes are trustworthy, and that the school is acting with integrity.

Schools need NZQA's approval (called "Consent to Assess") to be able to operate NCEA fully as a school.

NZQA audits schools about every three years and they produce a report, called an MNA Report ("Monitoring National Assessment"). The audit looks back on the school's activities since their last report and records how well the school has addressed any issues from back then, and identifies if there are any new issues to be addressed.

NZQA's report can also include advice on what the school could also consider for the future.

NZQA is one of the two Government agencies who act as watch-dogs for the public. Through its audits and reports, NZQA ensures that schools and their staff are doing the right things for students.
