Last year the Minister of Education announced changes to NCEA that will come into effect in 2024.

We are one of several schools nationally who are helping pilot and develop some of the new standards and ways of achieving NCEA. We are involved in the following pilot programmes:

- Te Reo Matatini me te Pāngarau • Literacy and Numeracy
- Tongan

We are also one of a few schools nationally recognised as a Ministry of Education (MOE) Hub School for the change process. This means the MOE will regularly seek our schools and staff's advice about what is proposed and how it could be improved.
