

Board of Trustees Policy: Information Technology



Policy Statement

 James Cook High School Board of Trustees acknowledge that students and staff get maximum educational benefit from the use of the Internet and ICT in a safe environment. The use of the Internet and ICT shall enhance student learning opportunities, and improve their skills in modern technology.

Guidelines

- 2. Policy and procedures apply to all members of the James Cook High School community, while at school, on school business, or using school equipment or resources.
- 3. The Principal shall authorise a set of procedures for use and management of the Internet and ICT.
- 4. Safety mechanisms are built in to the school network.
- 5. Student users, Staff and Board members must sign a Use Agreement. This agreement will acknowledge
 - a. that the School Values apply
 - b. that the school has a right to monitor use
 - c. there will be disciplinary consequences for misuse
 - d. that some forms of misuse are illegal, and could be dealt with as such
 - e. Professional development will be provided for staff
- 6. The Principal will ensure the school and staff are prepared for the Digital Readiness programme that will be rolled out in 2020 which will include
 - a. Professional development and support for staff is available and on going
 - b. The school is adequately resourced to meet the needs of the students
