

## Board Policy: Health, Safety and Welfare



## **Policy Statement**

 Through the development of effective Health and Safety procedures, practices and guidelines, a safe physical and emotional environment can be achieved for all students, staff and visitors.

## Guidelines

- 2. Comply in full with any legislation currently in force.
- 3. Ensure that there are relevant Procedures and Administrative Guidelines and compliance with these regarding both physical and emotional safety for students, staff and visitors.
- 4. The Ministry of Education advises that to address the requirements of NAG 5, Boards should ensure that:
  - School policies and/or procedures and practices meet all legislative requirements for health and safety;
  - Staff and students are aware of and understand these policies and/or procedures;
  - c. School policies and/or procedures on health and safety complement health education programmes for students; and
  - d. Health and safety issues are regularly monitored and reported on.
