



# Board Policy: Self-Review

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## Policy Statement

1. James Cook High School Board will ensure that effective systems and procedures are properly documented, and self-review processes are maintained to promote an effective school and continuous school improvement is enabled. These will be based on procedural and administrative guidelines.
2. The Board, through the Tumuaki, will provide a framework for reviewing all aspects of the school's operations.
3. This will be managed or reported to the Board as part of the annual workplan.

## Guidelines

4. The Board will:
  - a) In accordance with legislative requirements, develop strategic and annual plans which document how the school is giving effect to the NELPs (National Education & Learning Priorities)
  - b) Maintain:
    - i. an on-going workplan programme for the monitoring of the strategic and annual plans, and the regular review of policies;
    - ii. a cycle for routinely and regularly reviewing student achievement; and
    - iii. a cycle of self-review based on the Board Assurance Statements as published by ERO
  - c) Report in the Board's annual report, through the Analysis of Variance, on progress against the Boards determined framework.

5. This policy should be read in conjunction with the Education and Training Act 2020, other official requirements and advice from NZSTA.
